EXPECTATIONS, RULES, & DRESS CODE

Expectations

- PA Cyber staff, administration, and local security officers will be supervising this event.
- All PA Cyber rules and policies will be enforced.
- Please refer to the student handbook for any questions regarding rules at school functions.
- Absolutely no alcohol or tobacco is permitted.
- Any student/guest suspected of using alcohol or any controlled or illegal substance will be removed from the dance. Parents will be called to escort the person home.
- Students who purchase tickets are required to inform their guest of all contract rules. Guests are required to abide by all school rules and the terms of this contract.

Rules / Guidelines

- You must be registered to attend the Prom.
- All participants must follow the PA Cyber board-approved health & safety plan when attending school-sponsored events and activities.
- Any student dancing in a manner that is offensive to any chaperone will be removed from the dance floor and/or parents called and sent home.
- Any student or guest exhibiting disruptive behavior will be removed from the dance and parents called.
- Students who are removed from the Prom risk their participation in graduation or other

student activities through the end of the school year.

- Students are not allowed to reserve or use hotel rooms the night of the dance.
- Payment: Checks/money orders will be accepted from PA Cyber students/ parents **only**.
- No reimbursement or refund will be given if asked to leave the dance for not following the rules.
- If you leave the venue, you will not be allowed back in.

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Dress Code

Semi-formal dress is preferred but not required. The following dress code/restrictions will be in effect. Violations may result in non-admittance. If dress code violations occur after admittance, student/attendee may be removed from the dance. Any questions involving the dress code should be directed to the PA Cyber Prom Committee.

Appropriate Attire

Dresses, tuxedos, suits, dress pants/slacks worn appropriately. Collared dress shirts with long sleeves, worn with a tie or bow tie (alternatively, a tux shirt with a decorative button). Jackets or blazers.

Inappropriate Attire

- No sagging styles
- No jeans
- · Shirts must remain on & tucked in for the entire dance
- Formal dresses cannot be shorter than fingertip length with arms fully extended
- · Dress slits may not be higher than fingertip length with arms fully extended
- The back of the dress may not be lower than the natural waistline (belly button)
- No bandanas or canes
- No baseball caps
