



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who is eligible to attend?

One member of the couple must be a junior or senior currently enrolled and attending PA Cyber. PA Cyber seniors who have graduated before Prom are also eligible to attend. Invited guests attending the Prom must be enrolled in at least 10th grade and a maximum age of 20 years. Persons over the age of 20 are not permitted to attend.

Can I bring a guest?

What if my date is out of High School but not enrolled in College?
